




Create your Cardflow

1. Enter Course Title

2. Enter Hashtags





Click on the title of the Cardflow to begin building your content.



This is the Cardflow builder.

By default Card 1 is always loaded.

Since we are just starting this Cardflow build, card 1 is empty.



Select the template you would like to use for your first card. In most cases this will be a Content Template.






Notice the Content template is now highlighted.

You may choose to upload an image from your computer or mobile device.

Select a card background color for your card.

For white enter FFFFFF.

Use the Card Editor to design your card. The card editor functions very much like any word processor you use.



Note: Each card can only have one image uploaded.
You may choose to link to images elsewhere on the internet as long as you have the rights.



Right click on the link and select
"Copy Link address.
On you mobile device hold down
on the link and select "Copy
Link URL"



Uploading Images cont.







Note: Consider setting the image with with a %.
Example: 20%, 40%, 75% 90%. This will ensure a optimal display on mobile devices.
If you set using a percentage you can leave the height filed blank.
Fill in the Alternative text field with a brief description of the image. This is to support accessibility and screen readers.

Design Tips



With the Editor image you will provide a link to the image. You can source your own images from the web so long as you have the rights and permission to use them. Alternatively you can use a free image server like Google photos, Imgur, Flickr 500px or Dropbox to serve your own images. You can also upload an image to Cardflow for use. See the previous pages "Uploading Images" for instructions.



Experiment with color combinations when determining the background color vs text color of your cards. Black text on white card can serve a purpose but white font on a colored card can be eye catching.

Note: For white we recommend Bright Silver. This way you can actually see the font in the Card Editor.

- For variety consider different color cards throughout a course while keeping to a theme.
- Remember Learners today do not want to be bombarded with text. This is the post Twitter age and short and easy to read is ideal. We recommend you design with no scrolling. Consider adding another Card instead.
- Currently you are allowed 20 Cards in one Cardflow. This is to facilitate keeping learners engaged. Cardflow learning should be designed so users can complete one Cardflow in under 5 minutes.

You can embed video from **YouTube** using YouTube's embed functionality.

You should set the width of your video to no larger than 350. Below is a sample embed code. Any source code like the sample below must be placed into the source view.
